Outreach Highlights – Some highlights from last month.

Presidio of Monterey – I was invited by a friend who works on this local military base to speak at Areopagus, a new outreach that he is spearheading along with one of the Army chaplains. I was the first speaker for this meeting. Soldier turnout was low, but I shared one of my messages (which was well received), and the pastors and volunteers had a great time of discussion on evangelism. It was a blessing, and I'm looking forward to speaking there again.

Boogie on the Avenue – This is a large street festival that takes place in downtown Campbell, just a few blocks from our church. We've had some issues with the free speech rules and locations in the past, but this year the free speech area was near a busy corner, and we had a lot of foot traffic and many good conversations. But I want to ask for prayer for one person in particular. His name is Jim, a militant atheist I talked to, mostly through social media, for years. On Saturday we had the chance to talk face to face again, and as usual he was very hostile toward the faith (He takes some extreme views even most atheists don't). Pray that God changes his heart and brings him to repentance.
