HELLO FRIENDS! It's great to have the privilege of sharing a bit about our family, and our work with Open Air Campaigners. God has done amazing things with this ministry over the last 100+ years and we are excited to see what plans He has for us here in the Bay Area, and Northern California. We hope you'll consider joining us in our journey.

WHAT IS OPEN AIR CAMPAIGNERS? - *Open Air Campaigners (OAC) is an evangelistic ministry of preaching the Gospel to lost people and mobilizing the body of Christ to do the same, primarily through effective open-air outreach, but also through training and mentoring.*

Our mission is to take the gospel of Christ out from the church and into the public arena, and to teach others to do the same. Day in and day out you will find our evangelists proclaiming Christ on busy city sidewalks, in marketplaces, in parks, on college campuses, and in neighborhoods. Anywhere that people move and gather, you will find our 'pulpit.'

OAC began in 1892 when a lawyer in Australia named E. P. Field, began preaching the Gospel in Sydney. He was concerned that the majority of Australians did not attend church. ***If someone did not take the Gospel to them, how would they ever hear?*** The group of people who came to help E.P. Field first called themselves the New South Wales Prayer Band. Later, the name Open Air Campaigners was adopted.

OAC has always followed the principle of taking the Gospel to where the people are, rather than waiting for them to come to us. OAC's evangelists have always been innovative. Early in our history, we adopted visual techniques, including using sketchboards to illustrate our messages. The sketchboard continues to be our primary outreach tool, and continues to be very effective in reaching people with the message of the Gospel.

In 1956 Open Air Campaigners came to North America. Jim Duffecy, who had been converted to Christ at an OAC meeting himself, led the initial team and had a profound impact upon the entire history of the work in North America. He was appointed International Director at the first International Conference of Open Air Campaigners in 1966 and in 1978 became the International President.

Today, the legacy E.P. Field started, and Duffecy carried on continues. **OAC operates in a dozen states, and over 30 foreign countries**, and is still expanding. Our current goal is to impact the 25 largest metro areas in the US by 2025, and the Bay Area Branch one of the most recent steps toward that goal. God has been very faithful, and we are excited to see what else He has in store!



ABOUT THE BEAUDOINS - Dan was saved in his teens, and from early in his Christian life has felt a desire to be involved in full-time ministry. He was called to street evangelism in 2008, through an evangelism boot camp run by Living Waters. Since then, it has been his passion, and his primary activity when not working. **Dan has been involved in many types of outreaches, from tract distribution to open-air preaching, mall ministry, teaching evangelism classes, organizing conferences, leading outreach teams and individually mentoring others in sharing their faith.** Since 2015 Dan has been a missionary evangelist with Open Air Campaigners, tasked with



planting a mission branch and reaching the San Francisco Bay Area with the Gospel through outreach, raising up additional full-time evangelists, and equipping and encouraging Christian believers and churches in the area to share their faith.

Dan has been married to Becky for more than years, and they have two daughters, Naomi and Melody. Becky was raised in a strong Christian family and came to Christ early in life. Since graduating college with a teaching degree, she has worked teaching preschool, kindergarten and children's music. She also works homeschooling Naomi and Melody. Both girls have also professed Christ, and are very active in church.

OUR FUTURE PLANS – There is so much to do, and so many opportunities for ministry, but here are some more immediate goals:

- **Continue our outreaches across the Bay Area** - We have regular outreaches in San Jose, Santa Cruz, Palo Alto, Oakland, San Francisco. Let us know if there is a good spot near you!
- **Kids Bible Clubs** - Very often the best way to reach a family is through the kids. We are working with kids Bible clubs and other activities, and planning more.
